



## COSTUMES

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I love productions when you kids play kids. These costumes should be easy for most of you to obtain. Each group will be given specific clothing types and color groupings. Please adhere to these. A note before we start. *These are costumes. Please don't show up for a check in what you wore to school that day.*

**Jocks:** The named jocks and basketball players will wear their uniforms for the entire show. PP will provide the uniform. You need white socks and sneakers. The ensemble jocks should dress in athletic clothing. Your colors are red, and white, but you can also have a **little** blue. Running pants, warm up jackets or blue jeans. Sneakers. *No logos, sayings, shorts or other Milton team uniforms.*

**Cheerleaders:** You will wear your uniform for the entire show. PP will provide the uniform. You need white socks and white 'keds' style sneakers.

**Skaters:** Your colors should be muted. Gray, Tan, Blue, Black. Jeans, layers, Jackets over T's. Sweatshirts, hoodies, knit caps, sneakers. Loose clothing. No all black – you are not goth. *No logos, sayings, shorts, ripped jeans, baggy pants that show your underwear, school or team names.*

**Brainiacs:** Plaid, stripes, checks. Use red only as an accent in the plaid. No red and white check or stripe. Pants, ties, sweater vests, suspenders, pocket protectors, glasses, shoes or sneakers.

**Thespians:** Your colors are jewel tones...green, purple, royal blue. Girls should be in flowy clothing – maybe a long skirt or dress. Think 60's hippies. Long hair, scarves, peasant blouses. Dress shoes. Boys are a little harder. Chinos or dress pants, button down shirt, scarf around neck. Dress shoes

**Ms. Darbus:** You will need 2 outfits. Caftan top and long skirt or dress. One should be a purple print if possible, scarf, lots of jewelry, drop earrings, dress shoes.

**Ms Tenney:** You need a professional outfit – a suit if possible. We have some in the costume room, so see me before you purchase anything.

**Ryan:** You need 2 outfits. Trendy hipster. We would like to see some teal and pink. Maybe a vest with one? See me.

**Sharpay:** You will also need 2 outfits. I am not sure right now what PP will provide. See me.

**Gabriella:** You also need 2. We would like you to be preppy, similar to brainiacs. One of your costumes needs to have a good amount of red to show your connection to Troy. See me for specifics.

Now that you know what to get, **how and where** are you supposed to look? These should not be hard to find. They are current clothing and you have the movie for reference. Start with your own closet. Then go to places like Savers. You would be surprised to see what you can get there.
